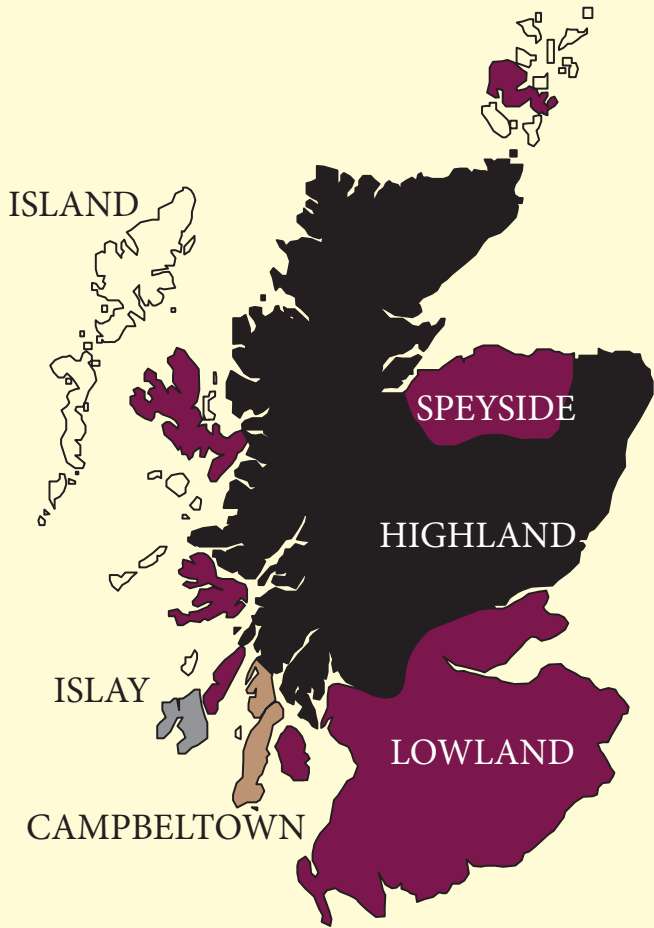

As You Like It £7.15
Big & rich. Spices, supple peat, good sweetness.

Ardbeg £5.50
Peat effervesces with tangy lemon & lime notes, black pepper pops with sizzling cinnamon-spiced toffee.

Auchentoshan 12yr old £3.95
Crème Brulee nose with a burst of citrus, nuttiness & leafiness. Smooth & sweet with hints of tangerine & lime.

Balvenie 17yr old £11.00
Finished in Islay casks, this single malt has a delicate hint of peat & its lingering finish is richly honeyed.

Balvenie 12yr old £4.25
Nutty sweetness, cinnamon spiciness & a delicately proportioned layer of sherry, with a long warming finish. Smooth & mellow acidic taste & a dry peppery finish.

Bowmore 12yr old £3.95
Smokiness balanced by heather honey sweetness. Chocolate, pear & citrus bouquet.

Bunnahabhain 12yr old £3.50
Intense & sweet with peaty hints. A rather rustic but delicate taste with a pleasant long full finish of ripe fruit & honey.

Chivas Regal 12yr old (Deluxe Blend) £4.00
Light spice & black pepper on the tail. Lingering notes of cereal sweetness. A spicy, beautifully balanced blend. Lots going on here.

Cragganmore 12yr old £5.95
A strong malty taste with hints of sweet wood smoke & sandalwood. The most complex nose of any malt whisky.

Dalmore 12yr old £4.50
Mouth-filling & chewy. Lot of cream toffee with a malty spice buzz throughout.

Dalmore 15yr old £6.35
Medium, lovely delivery. Zesty orange, Curaçao, chocolate. Winter spice, stem ginger in syrup. Hints of anise & a little hickory.

Dalmore Cigar £13.50
Reasonably simple, Christingles (orange Zest & clove with a touch of cinnamon), more mid-palate than palate-coating.

Dalwhinnie 15yr old £5.00
Malty. Walnuts steeped in manuka honey with vanilla sponge. Gentle smoke weaves its way through the cereal with a touch of spice.

Fettercairn Fior £5.00
This whisky has an astonishingly rich flavour of cocoa, espresso, spices, fruit & almond.

Glenfarclas 10yr old £3.95
Delicately light, with a mouth-watering combination of maltiness, smokiness & sherry sweetness. Hints of dried fruit, vanilla, cinnamon & cloves.

Glenfarclas 15yr old £5.25
Full bodied with super balance of sherried sweetness, malty tones & peaty flavours.

Glenfiddich 12yr old £3.95
Characteristic sweet, fruity notes. Develops into butterscotch, cream, malt & subtle oak flavours.

Glenfiddich 15yr old £5.25
Silky smooth, revealing layers of sherry oak, marzipan, cinnamon & ginger. Full-bodied & bursting with flavour.

Glenfiddich 18yr old £7.60
Richly delivers luxurious dried fruit, peel & dates. Overlaid with elegant oak notes.

Glenlivet 12yr old £3.95
Apple cores, fresh & fruity trifle & creamy citrus. Long & delicious, almonds & apple.

Glenlivet 18yr old £8.55
Full & rich with notes of chewy, tannic oak. Manuka honey & walnut with Cox's apples & orange peel.

Glenkinchie 12yr old £4.95
Notes of fresh cereal & grist, some barley sweetness & a nutty note.

Glenmorangie 10yr old £4.25
Velvet textured with delicate, honeyed overtones & a burst of citrus, vanilla & almonds.

Glenmorangie Signet £17.50
A contrast of rich sweetness with an explosive crackle of sizzling spices & bitter mocha.

Highland Park 12yr old £3.95
Exceptionally smooth. Succulent with smokey dryness, heathery-honey sweetness & maltiness.

Haig Club (Single Grain) £4.95
Toffee & vanilla with pleasant supporting oak notes. Fresh banana a hint of nougat & honeycomb pieces.

Isle of Jura 10yr old £3.60
The palate is thick & full with more cereal, this time a barley fudge sweetness creeps in with a touch of aniseed.

Isle of Jura Superstition £3.95
Sweet & porridge-like, with hints of white pepper & black forest honey. Light & oily.

Lagavulin 16yr old £6.50
Very thick & rich. A massive peaty mouthful of malt & sherry with good fruity sweetness, but also a wonderful sweetness.

Laphroaig 10yr old £4.25
Suprising sweetness with hints of salt & layers of peatiness. Full bodied & lingering.

Macallan Amber £6.50
Fragrant oak finish, with the mince pie notes. The second level in the 1824 Series, after the more citrus-led Gold.

Macallan Gold £4.50
Citrus & boiled sweets rule the palate, along with hints of ginger & cinnamon.

Macallan Ruby £14.65
The finish is medium sweet, malty & slightly dry. Big, bold, fruity sherried.

Macallan Sienna £7.55
Fruity & slightly spiced with a touch of anise. This is where the 1824 Series becomes more intense.

Monkey Shoulder (Blend) £4.25
Very malty, creamy delivery with a suggestion of berry fruit. Juicy toasted barley, cloves & butterscotch.

Robert Burns Malt £4.25
Fruity, notes of custard & warm pastry, more orchard fruit, some tart citrus.

Royal Lochnagar 12yr old £4.25
Pleasant; an initial sweetness is quickly overtaken by acidity. Dry; medium-length.

Talisker 10yr old £4.50
Full bodied with huge plumes of smoke & volcanic, peppery peat. Intense. Long finish, barley, malt.

Tomatin 12yr old £3.95
Toasted bread maltiness, succulent pear & crisp apple fruit with charcoal & peaty smokiness & dry nutty wood.

Yamazaki Malt 12yr old £8.50
Smooth & soft with good sweetness & winter spice. A lovely citrus note with more tropical fruit notes & a little rum.
